HUBBERTS BRIDGE COMMUNITY CENTRE

The community centre at Hubberts Bridge is a large function hall that can be booked and used by anyone for events such as weddings, family parties and other social gatherings.

Fix My Street is available to anyone to report issues such as potholes and damaged signs etc.

When reporting you have the option to remain anonymous, however we would recommend completing the report with your details. It is usually worth taking a photograph of the issue you are going to report and uploading it to the site in support of the problem you are highlighting.

Alternatively, you can contact one of the Parish Councillors who can help you complete the report.

DIAL 101

101 is an easy to remember number which can be used to contact your local police about crimes or concerns that do not need an emergency response.
